Tamil Nadu Acts and Ordinances

The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 28th September 2021 and is hereby published for general information:—

ACT No.20 OF 2021.

An Act further to amend the Tamil Nadu Court-fees and Suits Valuation Act, 1955.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Seventy- second Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Court-fees and Suits Valuation (Second Amendment) Act, 2021. Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification, appoint.

2. In Schedule-II to the Tamil Nadu Court-fees and Suits Valuation Act, 1955,— Amendment of Schedule-II.

(1) in Article 3 in column (1), for the entry "Two thousand rupees" in column (3) against item (ii) in column (2) thereof, the entry "One thousand five hundred rupees" shall be substituted;

(2) in Article 11 in column (1), for the entry "One thousand rupees" in column (3) against item (i) in clause (r) in column (2) thereof, the entry "Seven hundred fifty rupees" shall be substituted.
